This translation is not intended to be sung.

Your love is in heaven and your truth so perfect. I live in sorrow imprisoned; you are my light, your glory my support. Behold not with malevolence the sins of humankind, but forgive and cleanse. And so, O Lord, beneath your wings be our peace forever more.

In June 1893, after having been deposed from her throne in Howais, the imprisoned Queen Lilinokalani wreste a hymn to sell of her love of God, so great that she wheal that even the sins of those who imprisoned her be forgiven.
